**UP**

I ..... to be honest and kind to strangers.

**LOOK**

All the photos she took is an enjoyable way for Amanda ..... her time in Italy.

10 Tom has been gaining weight, so he has decided to eat less fast food.

**CUT**

Tom has decided ..... fast food because he's been gaining weight.
