STUDENT A

A. See how many of these sentences you can complete about the First (FCE) exam:

- 1. The exam has 5 sections: Reading, *Use of English*, Writing, Listening, and Speaking.
- 2. Each section of the exam is worth 20% of the final mark.
- 3. Combined, The Reading and Use of English exams have 7 activities.
- 4. Reading Parts 5 and 6 are worth 2 points each. The others are worth 1.
- 5. For Writing Part 1 you must always write an essay.
- 6. Both writing parts are worth *20* points.
- 7. It is important to consider who the *target reader* of your writing is so that you write in the correct style.
- 8. The Listening exam lasts approximately 40 minutes.
- 9. During the Speaking exam, there are 2 examiners and 2 candidates in the room.
- 10. Some parts of the Speaking exam are individual and some are interactive.
