3. Netball - A non-contact team sport derived from basketball, primarily played by women in British Commonwealth countries.
4. Curling - An ice sport that involves sliding stones on ice towards a target, played in countries with cold climates like Canada.
5. Jai alai - A high-speed ball game originating from the Basque region.
6. Sumo wrestling - A traditional Japanese sport where two wrestlers compete to force each other out of a circular ring.
7. Cricket - A bat-and-ball team sport played in many countries, especially in England and former British colonies.
8. Sepak takraw - A Southeast Asian sport similar to volleyball, but players can only use their feet, knees, chest, or head to touch the ball.
